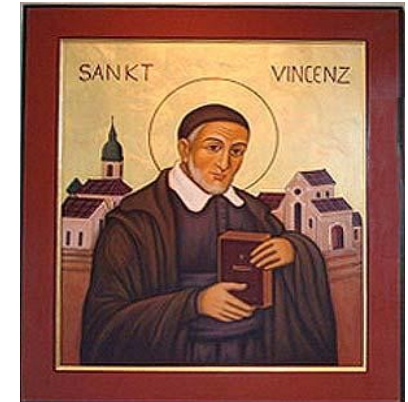

A Guide of Cemetery Rules and Guidelines

Rules and Guidelines

St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Cemetery

The cemetery provides a dignified burial place for the faithful departed. The cemetery offers services and facilities in harmony with the teaching of the Church, and show a degree of care that reflects the spiritual values inherent in the tradition of the Catholic burial.

Guidelines are designed for the express purpose of governing the activities in the Catholic Cemetery for the mutual protection and benefit of lot holders and the cemetery as a whole. They are established with certain restrictions to ensure uniformity and control within the cemetery grounds.

These guidelines are not intended to be restraining, or all inclusive, but rather to define an orderly plan of operation, care and permanent maintenance. A complete set of the rules and regulations are kept on file at the cemetery office and are available for your inspection during regular business hours. With this understanding in mind, the lot holder is requested to honor the following provisions.

Specific Guidelines

The purchaser of a plot in St. Vincent de Paul's Cemetery does not acquire the property itself, but only the "right of burial".

No interment will be permitted in the cemetery, or rights acquired by the purchaser, until such time that full payment has been received for the plot.

The interment fee is separate and distinct from the purchase of the "Right of Burial". This fee must be paid in full prior to the interment.

Grave spaces may be used for the burial of human remains only. Normally, a maximum of one interment or two interments (cremated remains) is permitted in a single grave.

The Cemetery is not responsible for the repair of the foundation or headstones of any interment.

Please note that by having the "right of interment", this property is not owned by any particular person and can not be adorned by items that are not in this rule and guideline brochure. Thank you.

Please observe the following rules:

Cemetery hours for visitation are from dawn to dusk.

Benches of any kind are not to be placed on or near any grave.

Planting of trees, shrubs, solar lights, shepherds hooks and other items must be approved by the Pastor or the Cemetery Manager.

Plantings must be of a reasonable size, style and variety. Only one 4" pot is allowed per grave and must be weighted to prevent toppling. The cemetery is not responsible for any damages due to trimming. Plants must remain within the grave boundaries.

No other items and adornments are allowed around the grave stone.

Do not drive or park on the grass.

No moving or setting of stones or markers.

Pets are not allowed outside of vehicles.

ATV's, snowmobiles and off road vehicles are prohibited.

Seasonal Regulations

April 1st through October 1st

One flower pot or cut Flowers or plants of a reasonable size must be placed in a secure vase or attached urn on the grave.

November 15th through March 15th

Winter wreaths or adornments that are placed for major holidays are allowed for 30 days from placement.

One American Flag is allowed for each interment.
